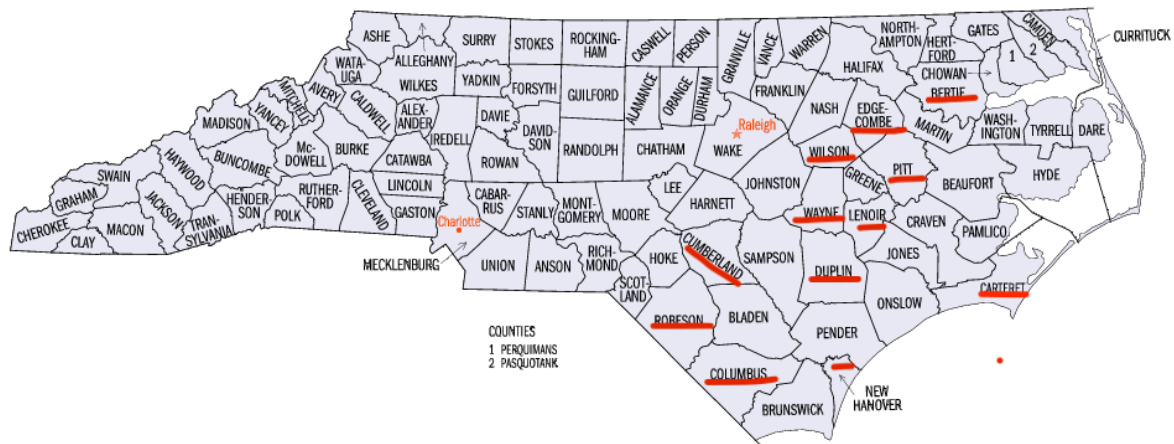


ECU Dietetic Interns complete their supervised practice in locations East of I-95. The ECU College of Allied Health Sciences Campus is in Greenville, North Carolina in Pitt County. About half of interns live in and around Pitt County. Interns assigned to Carteret, Duplin, New Hanover, Columbus, Robeson and Cumberland tend to live in those counties.

Interns are assigned to sites by Program Director starting in June and finalized in July to give interns ample amount of time to secure housing by rotation start dates in early September.
