Interns will have the opportunity to learn nutrition support on the surgical, medical and intensive care floors. Interns with be exposed to enteral nutrition, parenteral nutrition, nephrology, cardiology, diabetes, oncology and hepatic patients. The intern will have the option to follow patients with cardiovascular illness from the intensive care unit to cardiac rehab. Carolina East Health System provides a strong clinical experience with the ability to observe other disciplines. In the past, Interns have observed barium swallow procedures, PEG placements, ICU rounds and cardiac catheters. The track provides an opportunity to work with the diabetic educator, speech therapist and wound care nurse. We chart in the electronic medical record using the Nutrition Care Process. The dietitians are proactive members of the healthcare team with excellent rapport the doctors and clinical staff.
